Garbage needs to be separated according to separation guidance and taken out on designated collection day and at designated place. Please confirm those days by their colors in a Japanese calendar.

## *The type of Iwakuni City's designated plastic bags and how to use them.*

Iwakuni City has introduced its own designated paid plastic bags. There are two types of designated plastic bag, one for "CONBUSTIBLES" printed in red and one for "NON-CONBUSTIBLES" printed in green. Iwakuni City's designated plastic bags are available from supermarkets, convenience stores, drugstores and hardware stores. Size and price are common to both bags.

Put in Iwakuni city's designated bags

※Take out garbage at the locally designated place between 6:00~8:00 a.m. on the day of collection.

# ① Combustible garbage ⇒ Incinerated at Sunrise Clean Center

All combustible garbage that can not be recycled. ※Newspapers, cardboards, paper cartons and clothes should be taken out on the day of ⑦[Recyclable items].

How to take out : Use Iwakuni City's designated plastic bag with "THE DESIGNATED BAG FOR COMBUSTIBLES" printed in red. Refer to ⑨ or ⑩ when do not fit in the bag.

## ● Kitchen garbage

E.g. vegetable and fruit scraps, fish, egg and clam shells, bones, sauce, etc.

★Absorb the sauce or other liquid in paper or cloth.

Squeeze out excess liquid.

## ● Paper cartons

Paper cartons with aluminum foil lining, soap boxes, used tissue paper, cup noodle or ice cream containers, etc.

## ● Garden wastes such as leaves, plant trimmings, etc.

## ● Non-recyclable fabric products

E.g. Kimono, Kimono obi, Ski wear, Stuffed animals etc.

## ● Sanitary items

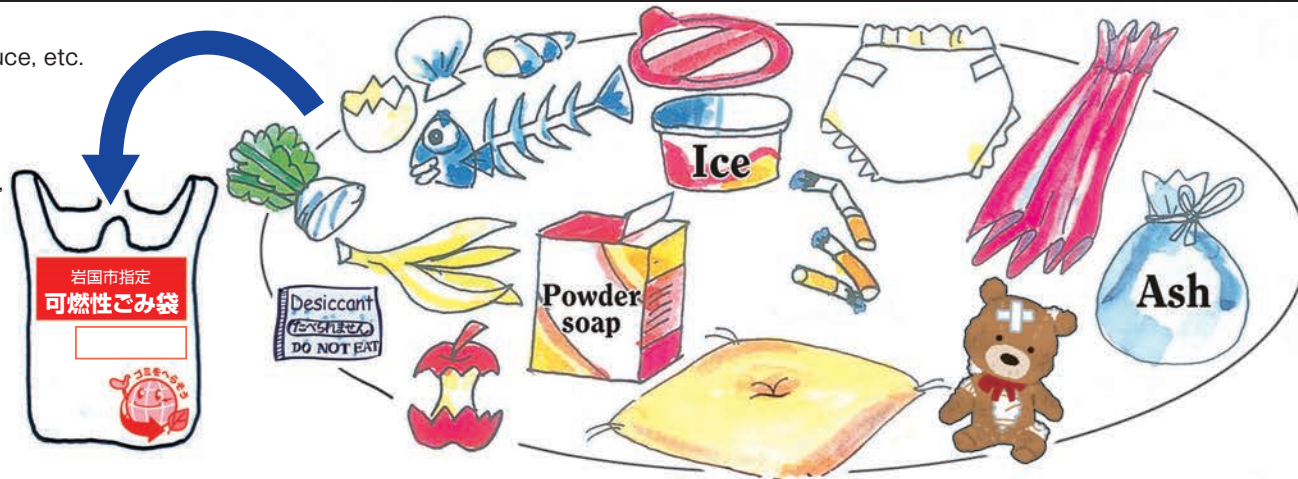
E.g. sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, paper toilets for pets, etc.

Contents of disposable diapers should be flushed down the toilet.

Please wrap kitchen garbage and used sanitary items in a small plastic shopping bag or newspaper.

## ● Others

Cigarette butts, disposable cellophane, etc.



Wrapping paper, papers and recyclable paper (receipt, business card, core of toilet paper) take out with ⑦[Recyclable items-Magazines/ Recyclable paper]. The tree size you may take them to city's disposal facilities directly refer to ⑩.

## ★Plastics with hard-to-go-away stains should be disposed as combustibles.

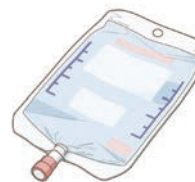

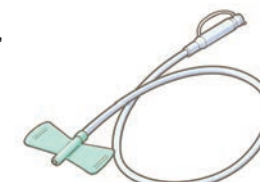
## ★Home medical waste should be disposed as combustibles.



Nutritional supplement, CAPD, Stoma bag, etc.



Syringe barrel  
※without needle



Tube, catheter, etc.  
※without needle



Syringe/intravenous needles shall not be taken out.  
Return them to the medical institution or pharmacy where they were provided.



## ② Bottles ⇒ Separated into bottles in clear, brown and other colors and recycled

Please remove caps and rinse the bottles inside in order to recycle.

How to take out : Use Iwakuni City's designated plastic bag with "THE DESIGNATED BAG FOR NON-COMBUSTIBLES" printed in green.

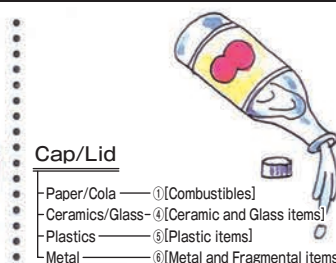
Refer to ⑩ when disposal of a large quantity.

- **Bottles for drink** (★remove caps and rinse inside well)  
E.g. juice, energy drink, liquor, medicine bottles
- **Bottles for food** (★remove lids and rinse inside well)  
E.g. glass bottles for jam, dressing, pepper, instant coffee
- **Bottles for cosmetics**

Note: Cups, ash trays, vases, flat glass, heat-resistant glass, and mirrors take out with ④[Ceramic and Glass items].



★1.8 liters sake bottles, coke bottles and other returnable bottles should be taken to stores where they were purchased.



## ③ Cans ⇒ Separated in aluminum and steel cans and will be recycled

Rinse the cans inside in order to recycle.

How to take out : Use Iwakuni City's designated plastic bag with "THE DESIGNATED BAG FOR NON-COMBUSTIBLES" printed in green.

Refer to ⑩ when disposal of a large quantity.

- **Cans for beverage** (steel beverage cans) E.g. juice, coffee, etc. ♻️
- **Cans for food** (★less than 2 liters) E.g. cans for seaweed, confectionery, etc.
- **Gas cartridges and spray cans** (★Be sure the cans are completely empty)

Note: Large cans such as cooking oil cans should be taken out with ⑥ [Metal and Fragmental items].

Aluminum cans take out with ⑦ [Recyclable items-Aluminum cans].

Do not place cans inside other cans.

Metal lid of a can is considered a part of the can.

Caps take out with ⑤ [Plastic items].



Gas cartridges and spray cans should be emptied and punctured.



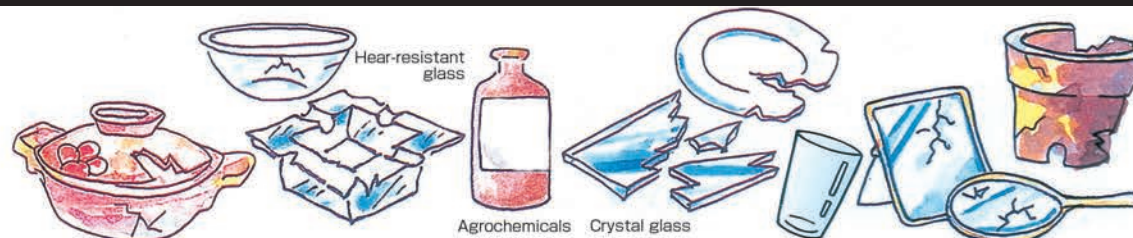
## ④ Ceramic and Glass items ⇒ Items will be sorted at the Recycle Plaza

Replacement for landfill trash: Should be recycled and used as resource as much as possible.

How to take out : Use Iwakuni City's designated plastic bag with "THE DESIGNATED BAG FOR NON-COMBUSTIBLES" printed in green.

Refer to ⑨ or ⑩ when do not fit in the bag.

- **Potteries**
- **Glass, Mirror** (★wrap broken glass and mirror in paper)
- **Agrochemical bottles** (dispose caps according to the material)
- **Other** Pieces of block and concrete (limited to one bag)  
Other beverage bottles and medicine bottles should be taken out with ② [Bottles].







## ⑥ Metal and Fragmental items → Separated at the Recycle Plaza and recycled

All plastics including items without ♻️ mark ※These items will be crushed and recycled as metal or aluminum.

How to take out : Use Iwakuni City's designated plastic bag with "THE DESIGNATED BAG FOR NON-COMBUSTIBLES" printed in green.

Refer to ⑨ or ⑩ when do not fit in the bag.

- **Aluminum foils and aluminum containers**  
(★Rinse out thoroughly dirt and contents before taking out for collection).
- **Metal cooking wares (including enamel)**  
E.g. pots, kettles, knives, cap or can openers and others.  
(★Attention! Do not include gas cartridges or spray cans into ⑥[Metal and Fragmental items]).
- **Metal items**  
(★Wrap cutlery in paper and put in designated bags).  
E.g. stationary items, scales, scissors, knives, sickles, razors, shaver, etc.
- **Fragmental items (Plastic products without ♻️ mark)**  
E.g. flower pots, toys, bathtub covers, sponge, etc.  
Extremely dirty plastic bottle, Chopping board, shoes, handbag and rain coat.
- **Others**  
E.g. clocks, calculators, AC adapters, CDs/DVDs, floppy discs, Records, cans for paint, marker and ball point pens, dry cleaning's plastic cover and others.

**Note: Batteries (dry cells and rechargeable battery, etc.) have to be taken out on the day of ⑧[Hard-to-dispose-of garbage].**  
**Heat-resistant glass should be taken out on the day of ④[Ceramic and Glass items].**

Cut any plastic sheets into 1m.

Cut any hoses and vinyl strings no longer than 1m.

- **Small electrical appliances**  
E.g. iron, hair dryer, toaster oven, boom box, vcr, electric kettle, etc.  
(★Electrical cords take out with ⑦[Recyclable items]).

※Small home electric appliances with built-in battery shall go to ⑦"Recyclable items" or "Collection box for used small home electric appliances."  
E.g. mobile battery, electric shaver, smartphone, e-cigarette, e-toothbrush, Portable game machine, handy cleaner

Please use the Collection Box installed at facilities of the city for used small household appliances or small household appliances with built-in battery.

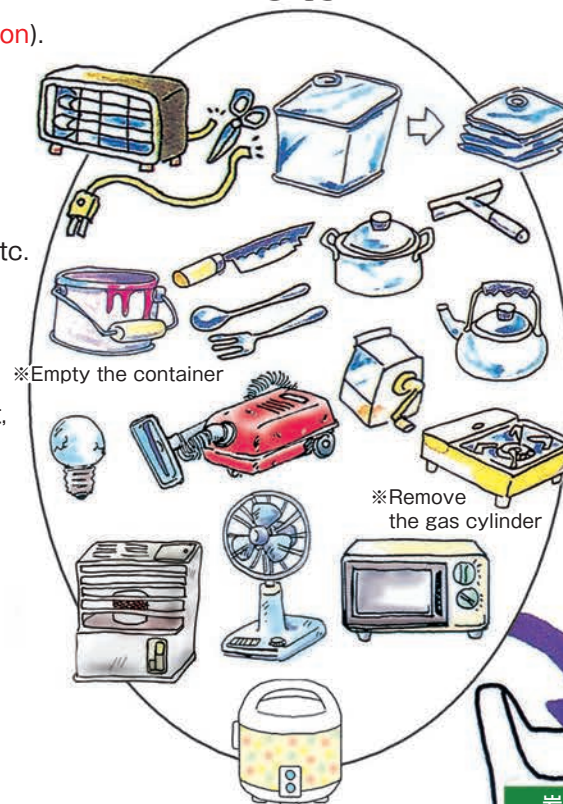
Please cooperate in the collection for the prevention of environmental pollution and efficient use of resources.

PC (desk top unit, display, laptop), cell phone, portable battery charger can be collected.

Location: Iwakuni City hall 1F, general branch office, branch, branch office (Iwakuni areas).

★Limited to that entering the inlet 40cm×20cm of the collection box.

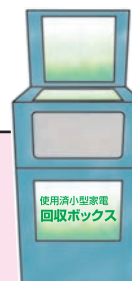

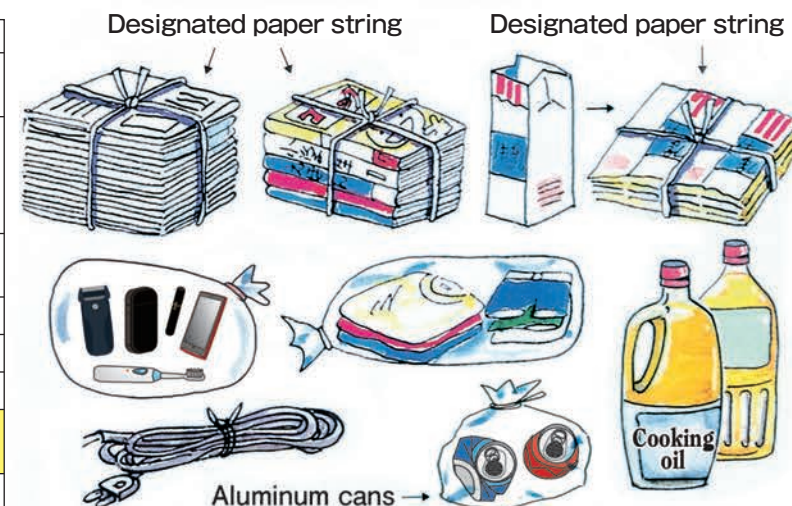
★Containers of hair manicure, insecticide, etc. that hold pressurized gas inside shall be included in ⑧[Hard-to-dispose-of garbage] for they may pose a risk of explosion or fire.



## ⑦ Recyclable items → Separated into the next 8 categories

Note: In case of rain, place these items in a transparent bag (or wait until the next collection day).

Category	How to take out
<b>1 Newspapers</b> <i>Newspapers, Leaflets</i>	Cross and tie a white paper string.
<b>2 Magazines / Recyclable papers</b> <i>Magazines, books, paper boxes, etc</i>	Cross and tie a white paper string. Small paper items put in a paper bag or between pages of magazines and books. Close a paper bag with scotch tape or kraft tape. Remove vinyl and metal.
<b>3 Paper cartons</b> <i>Milk and beverage cartons with  mark</i>	Rinse, cut open, flatten and dry. Cross and tie a white paper string.
<b>4 Cardboards</b>	Fold, tie with white paper string or gum tape.
<b>5 Cloth and reusable clothing</b>	Put the washed items in a transparent plastic bag.
<b>6 Aluminum cans</b>	After rinsing, put it in a transparent plastic bag.
<b>7 Electrical cord &amp; Small appliance with built-in rechargeable battery</b>	Cords must be bundled. Put small appliances in a transparent plastic bag.
<b>8 Cooking oil</b>	Put it in plastic bottles so that it will not leak.



## ⑧ Hard-to-dispose-of items → Separated into the next 4 categories and put in a transparent plastic bag.

How to take out : Use a transparent plastic bag. Please do not put in a lot.

These items can be taken out on any day of the collection for ②[Bottles], ③[Cans], ④[Ceramic and Glass items], ⑤[Plastic items], ⑥[Metal and Fragmental items].

### ① Batteries (dry /button /coin cell, rechargeable battery, lithium ion battery, etc.)

Button/coin cell, rechargeable battery and lithium ion battery insulate by sealing battery terminals with tapes.

### ② Fluorescent light, mercury thermometer

Fluorescent light put a box they were purchased in to prevent them from breaking.  
Put in a transparent plastic bag and write "sui-gin (Mercury)" on the bag.

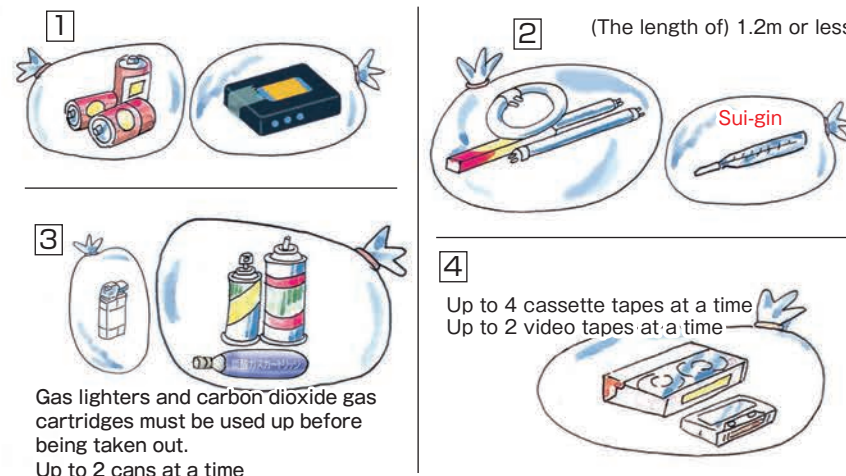
### ③ Gas cylinders

★Put gas cylinder and gas lighter in separate bags to prevent fire.

City does not collect reusable (refillable) CO<sub>2</sub> cylinders. They should be returned to the shop.

### ④ Video and cassette tapes

Plastic cases must be taken out with ⑥[Metal and Fragmental items],  
paper cases must be taken out with ⑦[Recyclable items- Recyclable paper].





**⑨ Oversized discarded items** ⇒ These items will not fit in Iwakuni City's designated plastic bags (size of LARGE (45L))  
Request the city authorized disposal contractor collect the items or take them directly yourself to the disposal facilities.  
**Note:** Items unable to dispose; large industrial wastes, agricultural tools, motor bikes, tires, car batteries, TV, refrigerator, air conditioner

○ **Check the following before taking out oversized discarded items**

- Can it be repaired?
- Can you give it to others?
- Can you take it to the Iwakuni City's disposal facilities?
- Can it be taken back to stores where it was purchased?

○ **Oversized discarded items collection tickets (stickers)**

There are two kinds of 250 yen and 500 yen sticker.  
Purchase tickets (stickers) at designated dealers.



○ **Procedures for the collection of oversized discarded items**

**1 Apply for the Housing Office at**

Business hours :  
Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Application period:  
At least seven days before the day of collection.

Advance notice may be made.

**2 Confirm the collection date, fee, name, address, phone no. , kind of garbage and notify you of garbage collection place and receipt number.**

Up to 10 items per household at a time  
Weight that can be carried by two people

**3 Purchase oversized discarded items collection tickets (stickers) for appointed amount of money.**

**4 Write your name and receipt number on tickets (stickers) and attach them in easily visible positions on oversized discarded items.**

**5 Put the oversized discarded in the designated place by 8 a.m. on the day.**

The oversized discarded items will be collected during the day.  
You do not need to be present for collection.

**Note;** Four household appliances (TV, refrigerator/ freezer, air conditioner, washing machine/dryer) and personal computer should not be disposed of at the city's disposal facilities or as oversized discarded items.

Four household appliances should be disposed of as in the following by paying the recycling fees.

○Request disposal at the store where you will buy appliance or where it was purchased. ○Ask for the contractor licensed by Iwakuni City. ○Carry it to the appointed place by oneself.

## ⑪ (Carcass)

- ★A pet owner must bring his dead pet to Sunrise Clean Center or Hongo Disposal Site on his own responsibility, or ask any professional handler for disposal.
- ★For animal except your pet is dead in your land, the owner of the property must take responsibility.
- ★For carcasses found on the public road or on public facility, ask the institutions concerned.

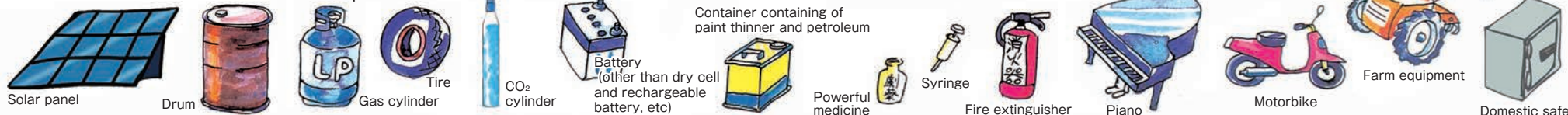
**(Others)** It is recommended that you discuss the day for community cleaning up or voluntary clean up with the local community.
